

Dudley Park Aquatic Centre Newsletter

Although we have experienced a cold June and July, it has been particularly dry and progress on the new Dudley Park Aquatic Centre has been pleasing. Visible changes are now taking place on a weekly basis, and the community can now see a considerable amount of the 'above ground' work taking place.

Construction progress over the months of June and July focused largely on completion of a considerable amount of concrete works in the pools and plant room area. The majority of the main steel structural work was also completed, and block work for the plant and store rooms is well underway.

Work in August will result in the foundation of the administration and changing room block being created. Roof work will also continue, as will pool water services development.

Below are two of the latest images taken on site on Thursday 30th July 2009.

Many of you may have noticed some damage to the grass areas in front of the pavilion and leading to the White Street end of the construction site. This was caused by vehicles that needed to deliver large materials to this side of the worksite, and Naylor Love have advised that no further access over grassed areas is required. Naylor Love will be repairing these grassed areas in August and September as part of the construction contract. We
